EMMANUEL CHRISTIAN SCHOOL (1168) Enrolment Scheme Amendment Commences 1 January 2026

Emmanuel Christian School is a State integrated school with a Christian Special Character which is defined in its Integration Agreement.

Enrolment

The School operates an enrolment scheme under Section 71 and Clause 16 of Schedule 20 to the Education and Training Act 2020 (Act). The School Board (Board) is legally responsible for managing enrolments and is required to work within the school's maximum roll as outlined in their Integration Agreement. The Board will manage the roll by offering a targeted number of places each year and assigning these places in accordance with priority categories.

The Act (Schedule 6, Clause 26) states that "The children of parents who have a particular or general philosophical or religious connection with a State integrated school must be preferred to other children for enrolment at the school".

Area of Reasonable Convenience

The Act (Schedule 20, Clause 16b) states that an enrolment scheme "must accord priority to applicants for whom the school is a reasonably convenient school". The Christian Education Network provides Christian education to the area bounded by the Rakaia River in the south, the Canterbury/Westland boundary along the Southern Alps in the west, Hurunui River to the North, and the Pacific Ocean to the East. This area is divided into catchments. The catchment for this school is described in the written description and shown in the associated catchment map.

Priority of Enrolment

Applications for enrolment close on the date published on the school's website (Closing Date) and all applications will be processed in the following order of priority as at this date:

Preference Applicants

A preference applicant is the child of a family which, in the opinion of the Emmanuel Proprietor Trust, have established a particular connection with the School through membership of a Christian Church whose beliefs are consistent with those of the Statement of Faith as defined within the Special Character of the School.

Priority 1 within catchment

- Preference Applicants who, on the Closing Date, reside within the school's catchment will be offered places in the following Priority order: Applicant;
 - a. Is a sibling of a current student
 - b. Is the child of a current permanent employee of Emmanuel Christian School
 - c. Is the child of a current permanent employee of a CEN School, CEN School Board member, or CEN Board of Proprietor member
 - d. Is currently enrolled at another Network School
 - e. Is a sibling of a student currently enrolled at another Network School
 - f. Has demonstrated a commitment to Christian education by any of the following:
 - i. Is attending a Christian school, Christian pre-school or home school, and has done so for one year or longer
 - ii. Has previously attended the school
 - iii. Has a parent who is a former student of the school
 - iv. Has a sibling who is a former student of the school

All other Preference Applicants who, on the Closing Date, reside within the school's catchment. Preference Applicants who, on the Closing Date, resides outside the school's **Priority** 2 outside catchment will be offered places in the following order: catchment Applicant; a. Is a sibling of a current student b. Is the child of a current permanent employee of Emmanuel Christian School c. Is the child of a current permanent employee of a CEN School, CEN School Board member, or CEN Board of Proprietor member d. Is currently enrolled at another Network School e. Is a sibling of a student currently enrolled at another Network School f. Has demonstrated a commitment to Christian education by any of the

- following: Is attending a Christian school, Christian pre-school or home
 - school, and has done so for one year or longer
 - Has previously attended the school ii.
 - Has a parent who is a former student of the school
 - Has a sibling who is a former student of the school iv.
- g. All other Preference Applicants who, on the Closing Date, reside outside the school's catchment.

All Preference Applicants will be given priority over all Non-Preference Applicants seeking enrolment. If the total number of applications from Preference Applicants is less than the number of places available, all Preference Applicants will be enrolled.

Non-Preference Applicants

Non-Preference Applicants may be considered for enrolment only if enrolment places remain after all Preference Applicants have been enrolled and the total roll is still less than the

maximum specified in the Integration Agreement. The maximum number of places available for Non-Preference Applicants will be governed by the maximum allowable under the Integration Agreement.	
Priority 3 -	Non-Preference Applicants who, on the Closing Date, resides within the

	c. All other Non-Preference Applicants residing outside the school's catchment

Catchment Area Written Description

Note that eligibility to enrol is based on the below written description of the catchment. Any associated maps are a visual representation of this description.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Starting from the intersection between Hawke Street and Marine Parade;

- East to the New Brighton Beach coastline
- North along the coastline to the mouth of the Waimakariri River
- West along the southern bank of the Waimakariri River to a point that aligns with the western end of Coutts Island Road
- Due south to McLeans Island Road
- East along the northern side only of McLeans Island Road to Johns Road (SH1)
 - o Including 562 McLeans Island Road
- South west along the eastern side only of SH1 to Memorial Avenue
- South east along the northern side only of Memorial Ave to Grahams Road
- North east along the northern side only of Grahams Road to Wairakei Road
- South east along the north eastern side only of Wairakei Road to Strowan Road
- Continue south east along the eastern side only of Strowan Road to Rossall Street
- Continue south east along the eastern side only of Rossall Street to Carlton Mill Road
- East along the northern side only of Carlton Mill Road to Bealey Avenue
- East along the northern side only of Bealey Avenue to Whitmore Street
- North along the western side only of Whitmore Street to Hills Road
- Continue north along the western side only of Hills Road to Shirley Road
- East along the northern side only of Shirley Road to New Brighton Road
- Continue east along the northern side only of New Brighton Road to Hawke Street
- East along the northern side only of Hawke Street to Marine Parade

Additional Entitlement to Enrol

This provision has been approved under Section 1(a) of the Education and Training Act 2020.

The Act (Section 75) states that "the Secretary may authorise an enrolment scheme to permit a student to enrol at the school as if the student lived in the home zone of the school".

Preference Applicants who are siblings of Emmanuel Christian School students enrolled at the date that the enrolment scheme is implemented by the School Board, who reside within the school's previously defined area of reasonable convenience (outer zone) will be considered as if they reside within the school's catchment. This area is bounded by the Rakaia River in the South, the Canterbury/Westland boundary along the Southern Alps in the West, Hurunui River to the North, and the Pacific Ocean to the East. Section 75 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 sets out the definition of a "sibling" for these purposes.

The School will maintain a list of students enrolled at the time of the implementation of the enrolment scheme change by the Board in order to enable determination of eligibility to enrol under this provision. If applying for enrolment under this part of the enrolment scheme, the sibling's name and evidence of a sibling relationship may be required by the School.

This provision will only apply to Preference Applicants who are siblings of a student who was enrolled at the School at the implementation date. This provision will not apply to Preference Applicants who have a sibling who attended the School at the implementation date, but who are no longer enrolled at the Preference Applicant's start date.

Note that the date of implementation is the date at which the Board officially adopted the enrolment scheme, rather than the date at which the enrolment scheme commences.

Parental Consent

- Non-Preference Applicants accept that education will be delivered in accordance with the special character of the school.
- All Applicants accept that they will be required to pay attendance dues as set by the Proprietor and these are compulsory.

Allocation of Places and Wait List

If there are more Applicants at any year level, in categories than there are places available, places will be allocated in priority order until a category is reached where the number of spaces available in that category is insufficient to accommodate the number of eligible students. Places will then be allocated by **ballot**.

If the total number of applications is greater than the number of places available, unsuccessful Applicants will have their names recorded on a waiting list at each year level within their relevant priority category. Applicants on the waiting list may be offered places at a later date if places become available. The waiting list will remain current until the Board next notifies the public that it is inviting applications for the next enrolment intake.

Notifications for Pre-Enrolment Processes

The Board must place a public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school indicating the likely number of places available and the significant pre-enrolment dates and procedures that will apply.

Definitions

"Applicant" means a prospective student for whom the application is being made.

"Closing Date" means the publicly notified date in each year by which applications for enrolment at the School are to be received.

"Maximum Roll" means the maximum number of students that should be enrolled for attendance at the School as prescribed from time to time under its Integration Agreement.

"Network School" means a school belonging to the Christian Education Network (CEN). CEN schools at the time of writing are: Aidanfield Christian School, Emmanuel Christian School, Hillview Christian School, Middleton Grange School, Rangiora New Life School, Rolleston Christian School.

"Proprietor" means the body corporate that has the primary responsibility for determining the special character of the school and for supervising the maintenance and preservation of that special character; and who owns, holds in trust, or leases the land and buildings that constitute the premises of the school.

"School" means Emmanuel Christian School.

Words which refer to the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.

Notes

- The selection processes described above will be the basis for students applying to enrol either at the beginning of, or during the school year.
- Applicants may be required to give proof of address or sibling relationship.
